

INVITATION TO BID

The Harpers Ferry-Bolivar Public Service District will receive bids until 2:00 PM, LPT October 31, 2017 at the Bolivar Town Hall, 60 Panama Street, Harpers Ferry, WV 25425. At this time all bids will be opened and read aloud.

Phase 2 – Contract 1 WWTP

The work covered by the Contract Documents includes, but is not limited to, the furnishing and installing of new aeration blowers, piping and diffusers, installation of new sludge pumps and piping, new scum removal piping and equipment, new chlorination and de-chlorination buildings, equipment and piping and new electrical controls. Project includes the demolition, removal and disposal of existing equipment, piping, blowers, motors and controls for the existing plant.

Phase 2 – Contract 2 COLLECTION SYSTEM

This project consists of the replacement of 10 grinder pumps and their respective alarm panels; approximately 765 feet of 3" PVC electrical conduits; the replacement of the Old Furnace Road Submersible Lift Station with an above ground Pumping Station and other miscellaneous work.

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One set of bid documents for the WWTP, Contract 1 may be obtained by submitting a \$150.00 nonrefundable deposit. One set of bid documents may be obtained for the Collection System, Contract 2, by submitting a \$75.00 non-refundable deposit. A \$15 charge will be added if plans are to be shipped.

Qualifying Bidders:

- Each Bidder must be registered with the West Virginia Department of Tax and Revenue prior to the deadline for receipt of bids. Each bidder's valid registration certificate number shall appear in the appropriate box on the Form of Proposal.
- All bidders are required to be licensed to perform work in the State as required by Chapter 21, Article 11, of the Code of West Virginia.
- A satisfactory bid bond furnished by a solvent surety company authorized to do business in the State of West Virginia, properly countersigned by a West Virginia Agent, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, payable to the Harpers Ferry – Bolivar PSD, shall be submitted with each bid.

Prospective Bidders should note the following:

1. NONDISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

2. SUSPENSION AND DEBARMENT

Recipient shall not entertain the use of businesses that are listed on the "System for Award Management (SAM)" at www.sam.gov in accordance with 2 CFR Part 1532 and Subpart B and C of 2 CFR Part 180.

3. WV ALCOHOL AND DRUG FREE WORKPLACE ACT

West Virginia Code 21-1d-5 provides that any solicitation for a public improvement construction contract requires each vendor that submits a bid for the work to submit at the same time an affidavit of compliance with the bid. The enclosed drug-free workplace affidavit must be signed and submitted in the first envelope as evidence of the vendor's compliance with the provisions of Article 1d, Chapter 21 of the West Virginia Code. Failure to submit the signed drug-free workplace affidavit in the first envelope shall result in disqualification of such bid.

4. DAVID-BACON WAGES

Bidders on this work will be required to pay the Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Rates. Failure to comply with any of the above requirements will result in the rejection of the bid.

Power of Attorney – Attorneys in fact who sign bid bonds or contract bonds must file with each bond a certificate and effectively dated copy of their power of attorney.

The apparent successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the accepted bid. The fee for the same shall be included in each bid.

The Harpers Ferry-Bolivar PSD, reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The bid opening procedure shall be a two (2) envelope system. The system shall consist of two (2) separate and distinct envelopes, each with proper identification. The envelopes shall be identified as "Bid Opening Requirements" and the other as "Bid Proposal". If mailed, both shall be submitted in a single, large envelope, labeled with the Contractor's name and address. See Bid Opening Guidelines and Checklist Form under Forms and Documents Section of the Contract Documents.
